Old Business

The Surveillance System has been installed with 5 additional cameras covering each door, the fellowship hall, the driveway of the parsonage, and part of the playground. We are checking into notifying people that they are on camera.

The Annual Lawn Festival will be held on July 23rd. The council approved this date rather than the 30th to accommodate the majority. Sue plowman asked if we want music for the Lawn Festival. We will wait to see if people miss it. The proceeds from the Lawn Festival will be donated toward the shoe boxes. The grill at the pavilion is rusted and will need fixed or replaced. Roy and Paul Duncan are looking into fixing it.

Joan Marshall on behalf of the Faith Promise committee asked to put baby bottles in the back of the church to collect donations for IUP's pro-choice organization that helps aid young pregnant women. This was approved by all. Bill Conger will be placed on the Faith Promise Committee.

Pastor Tom will be at Cherry Run Camp from July 31st through August 7th. He will be here for the service on the 31st, but we will need a guest speaker for the 7th.

The Gaga Court was built by the Adventure Camp kids, and all the kids love it.

DJ Rodkey is stepping down from the Church Secretary position, the voluntary Technology Coordinator position, as chairman of the Technology Committee, and all other committees effective on July 31st, 2016.

New Business
